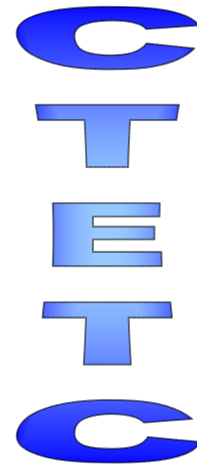
**Career and Technical Teaching Credential Program Information**
