- CAD 410 must be completed with grade of C and ENG 214 with a C- or better <u>before</u> enrollment in CAD 500GW. No concurrent enrollment allowed. Proof of community college equivalent for ENG 214 is required.
- Internships take place in final semester at university. The internship application must be submitted one semester prior
