<b>Start Date</b>	Ideally early to mid-August 2023
<b>Role</b>	A semi-long-term, almost full-time nanny for our nine-month old baby. This role is primarily for childcare, but ideally looking for someone who can help with some light housework while the baby naps or is with another caregiver. Parents will be working from home frequently, but not all the time. Person should be comfortable watching the baby solo for 8 hours/day, but also be comfortable with parents being home. We have an independent baby and are looking for someone who is interested in letting the baby take the lead while providing structure, emotional, and educational support.
<b>Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● General everyday care of the child (feeding, diapering, playing, napping, walking)</li><li>● Preparing meals / bottles</li><li>● Light housework (cleaning spills &amp; dishes &amp; laundry)</li><li>● No driving of the child will be required</li></ul>
