Housed in the <u>Marian Wright Edelman Institute (MWEI)</u> in the Health and Social Sciences Department, the SF State Jumpstart AmeriCorps Program is a workforce development program that employs SF State students to meaningfully impact children's early learning and development in underserved, culturally rich San Francisco preschools.

Community Engagement Coordinator Position

The Community Engagement Coordinator recruits, trains, and manages volunteers for various Jumpstart service projects that address specific program and community needs. The volunteers engaged can consist of a combination of college students, clubs/service organization members, family members of the children served, community members, Jumpstart alumni, corporate partners, donors/funders, and others who can participate in a range of service projects designed to deepen the site/program's impact and visibility within the community. Service project categories include one-day (short-term) events and/or multi-day (long-term) activities.

Community Engagement Coordinators serve 300 hours, 8-12 hours per week:

Earn and Learn: As the SF State Jumpstart Community Engagement Coordinator, you will earn \$22.00 per hour for your service. You have the opportunity to earn up to \$2,500 each semester (up to \$5,000.00 per year) for your service.

Please note that the Community Engagement Coordinator role is funded through Federal Work Study. Ensure you meet the eligibility requirements before applying.

Segal AmeriCorps Education Award: SF State Jumpstart AmeriCorps members who complete 300 hours of service for the full academic year are eligible to receive the honorary Segal AmeriCorps Education Award. The Segal AmeriCorps Education Award is a national service award of \$1,565.08 to be applied to current and/or future educational expenses, including tuition and loans. The Segal AmeriCorps Education Award recipients have the additional advantage of including the award on their resume for job and higher education consideration.
