Corps Member Position

- Early Childhood Teaching Practicum: Dive into hands-on experience in an off-campus San Francisco preschool, guided by a Mentor Teacher and supported by a dedicated Jumpstart Coach approximately 10 times per semester.
- Educational Enhancement: Enroll in a Monday evening EED course (4-7 PM) for 3-units, tailormade to complement your practical learning and count towards your <u>Associate Level Child</u> <u>Development Permit.</u>
- **Community Events**: Along with your peers, support two San Francisco community events attended by families and children of San Francisco.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ One Full Workday: Dedicate one 8-hour day per week (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, 8:30 AM 4:30 PM) in the Fall and Spring semesters.
- Section 2025 EED Course Participation: Course participation is required in the FA 2024 and SP 2025 semesters.
- 𝗭 Administrative Responsibilities and Additional Training as required

JOB COMPENSATION

• Earn and Learn: SF State Jumpstart AmeriCorps members earn \$22.00/hour for their classroom and community service. You can earn up to \$2,500 each semester (up to \$5000.00/year) for your service.* (*Conditions apply based on eligibility and program completion.)

SF State Jumpstart offers flexible compensation options to support student participation in the program:

- Federal Work Study (FWS) Award: If you are eligible for FWS, you can use this funding as your primary compensation method in our program. FWS is a form of federal financial aid for students who demonstrate financial need, allowing you to earn money for college through part-time work.
- AmeriCorps Stipend: For students who do not qualify for FWS or those who have exhausted their FWS funds, SF State Jumpstart offers a limited number of positions funded by AmeriCorps stipends. These positions provide an alternative source of compensation, ensuring that students have the opportunity to participate in our program regardless of their FWS status.

Segal AmeriCorps Education Award: SF State Jumpstart AmeriCorps members who complete 300 hours of service for the full academic year are eligible to receive the honorary Segal AmeriCorps Education Award. The Segal AmeriCorps Education Award is a national service award of \$1,565.08 to be applied to current and/or future educational expenses, including tuition and loans. The Segal AmeriCorps Education Award recipients have the additional advantage of including the award on their resume for job and higher education consideration.

Earn credits towards your Associate Level Child Development Permit. Exciting News: Preschool teachers in San Francisco ELS Programs earn between \$28.00 - \$37.00 per hour.
