As a Lead Teacher, you will manage and supervise all operations of an assigned infant/ toddler/ preschool classroom according to established procedures. Must hold or be eligible for State of California Commission on Teacher Credentialing Teacher Permit or above + BA in ECE or related field. A minimum of 175 days of 3+hours/day work experience within last 4 years and at least 2 years supervising adults. Exempt position.
